Laser hair reduction involves the use of a specific laser frequency to produce a heating effect that is intended to disable the hair follicle and the blood supply to the follicle in order to impair hair growth. The FDA has cleared a number of devices for permanent hair reduction, and this procedure can be performed on nearly every part of the body.

Popular treatment areas include the upper lip and face, legs, arms, and backs. Laser hair reduction does not require the use of an anesthetic, and it is common for newer equipment to incorporate a skin cooler to reduce the sensation of the treatment. Due to hair growth cycles and varying treatment efficiency, 90% hair reduction can typically be achieved within 5-8 treatments, treating a patient once monthly.

Patients with light skin and dark hair are going to typically react best to laser hair reduction treatments, but advances in laser technologies in recent years have allowed for successful results in nearly all skin types and hair colors.
